## Facts About Sexual Assault In North Dakota January – December 2008

- ❖ 854 primary victims and 409 secondary victims were served by 18 sexual assault crisis centers throughout North Dakota.
- ❖ At least **351** (**41%**) of primary victims were under the age of 18 years old at the time of the assault/s.
- ❖ At least **761 (89%)** of the **victims** were **female**.
- ❖ At least **814** (**95%**) of the **assailants** were **male**.
- **\*** 70% of the crimes were reported to law enforcement.
- ❖ At least 42% of <u>adult</u> victims contacted a sexual assault center about the crime within 2 days of the assault. 21% of <u>adult</u> victims contacted a sexual assault center within 3-30 days after the assault.
- ❖ At least 85% (727) of the cases were male assailant/female victim.
- ❖ At least 10% (86) of the cases were male assailant/male victim.
- ❖ At least 65% of the adult assaults were rape, 7% attempted rape, and 28% were sexual contact other than rape or attempted rape.
- ❖ In adult cases 9% of the assailants were strangers. In child cases 2% of the assailants were strangers.
- ❖ In at least 46% of all cases the assailant was a friend/acquaintance/date of the victim.
- ❖ At least 29% of all cases were incest or indicated a history of incest. In at least 9% of adult sexual assault cases reported, the victim also experienced sexual abuse/incest as a child.
- ❖ At least **9,429** services to **primary victims** were provided by crisis center advocates from January to December 2008.
- ❖ At least 49% of the assaults occurred in the victim's or assailant's home.
- ❖ At least 33% of the victims were **referred** to sexual assault service providers by **themselves**, **friends**, **or family members**.
